

ATTORNEY CLAUDE J. KRAWCZYK INVOLVED IN RESTORING MARQUETTE CAMPUS STATUE

The George Washington statue has returned to Wisconsin Avenue near the campus of Marquette University. The 133 year-old monument had been removed for restoration, which involved removing layers of black corrosion and the repair of splitting bronze. Attorney Claude Krawczyk currently serves as the president of The Westown Association, which raised funds for the restoration effort. In total, the restoration project cost more than \$100,000 to complete. Attorney Krawczyk had a special interest in the project, explaining "I can remember seeing [the statue] when I was a kid, it's been there all my life.
