

ATTORNEY CLAUDE J. KRAWCZYK INVOLVED IN RESTORING MARQUETTE CAMPUS STATUE

The George Washington statue has returned to Wisconsin Avenue near the campus of Marquette University. The 133 year-old monument had been removed for restoration, which involved removing layers of black corrosion and the repair of splitting bronze. Attorney [Claude Krawczyk](#) currently serves as the president of The Westown Association, which raised funds for the restoration effort. In total, the restoration project cost more than \$100,000 to complete. Attorney Krawczyk had a special interest in the project, explaining “I can remember seeing [the statue] when I was a kid, it’s been there all my life.
